<b>Eligibility:</b>	<p>All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA, Judo Scotland, BJC or AJA. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation</p> <p><b>Juniors:</b> Year of birth <b>2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009 or 2010</b> – Contest time 4 mins. (all Cadets may also compete in the Junior category)</p> <p><b>Seniors:</b> Year of birth – <b>Minimum age of 14 years on day of competition</b> – Contest time 4 mins.</p> <p><b>Masters:</b> Year of birth – <b>Minimum age of 30 years on day of competition</b> – Contest time 3 mins.</p> <p><b>Minimum grade – Green Belt</b></p> <p><b>It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.</b></p>
<b>Competition Format:</b>	<p>Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout.</p> <p>The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.</p> <p>This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.</p> <p>IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No 30 second rule</li> <li>• BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Minors categories.</li> <li>• Judogi measurements as per 2013 IJF rules.</li> <li>• 2017 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition</li> </ul> <p><b><u>New Rule</u></b></p> <p>All genders of all ages in all BJA licenced events are entitled to wear a T-shirt / Rash Guard at both the weigh in and during the contest should they wish to do so.</p> <p>The standard T-shirt / Rash Guard worn in all categories will be plain white with a round neck collar and have a maximum sleeve length up to 5cm above the wrist joint.</p> <p>There will be no advertising on the T-shirt /rash guard of any description other than the standard manufacturers label, maximum size of manufacturers label will be 3cm x 15cm and not visible when the jacket is tied in its normal position.</p>

	<p><b><u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event</u></b>; any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi <b>must</b> also have a white Judogi when required.</p> <p><b><u>Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.</u></b></p>
<p><b>Seeding:</b></p>	<p>Seeding for the Junior and Senior event will be based on the current GB Ranking list.</p>
<p><b>Weight Categories:</b></p>	<p><b>Junior Male</b> -55kgs, -60kgs, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kgs  <b>Junior Female</b> -44kgs, -48kgs, -52kgs, 57kgs, -63kgs, -70kgs, -78kg, +78kgs  <b>Senior Male</b> -60kgs, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kgs  <b>Senior Female</b> -48kgs, -52kgs, -57kgs, -63kgs, -70kgs, -78kgs, +78kgs  (STRANGLES AND ARMSLOCKS PERMITTED IN ALL CATEGORIES)</p> <p><b>Masters category 1: 30-39 years of age</b>  <b>Male</b> -60kg, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kg</p> <p><b>Masters Category 2: 40-49 years of age</b>  <b>Male</b> -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg</p> <p><b>Masters Category 3: 50+ years of age</b>  <b>Male</b> -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg  (STRANGLES AND ARMSLOCKS PERMITTED IN ALL CATEGORIES)</p> <p><b>Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).</b></p> <p>The Northern Ireland Judo Federation reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories.</p> <p>Competitors who are entering a category which is different to their sex assigned at birth are requested to contact <a href="mailto:safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk">safeguarding@britishjudo.org.uk</a> at the earliest opportunity.</p>

<p><b>Registrations and Weigh-In:</b></p>	<p>The official registration and weigh-in will take place –</p> <p><b><u>Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> April 2025</u></b></p> <p><b>Juniors</b> - 8.00am to 8.30am (Test Scales available)</p> <p><b>Seniors</b> - 8.30am to 9.00am (Test Scales available)</p> <p><b>Masters</b> - 11.00am to 11.30am (Test Scales available)</p> <p><b><u>Please note:</u> Competitors who are competing in both Junior and Senior or Senior and Masters categories should collect both their registration cards and weigh in during the allocated Junior/Senior weigh in time.</b></p> <p><b>An open weigh in will be conducted at this event therefore <u>ALL</u> competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt (a 0.8kg allowance will be given).</b></p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category.</p> <p>All Cadets who competed at the Saturday event and are competing in the Junior event on the Sunday <b><u>must register and weigh-in for the Junior event</u></b> during the allocated time, they will not be required to make their weight category limit but should be within 5% of the maximum weight limit for their weight category.</p> <p>Test scales will be available at registration (where the officials must be notified of any weight category changes).</p> <p><b>Please note: No changes of weight category will be permitted after the player has weighed in on the official scales.</b></p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence/membership to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade requirement (valid digital versions accepted).</p> <p><b>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except if required for membership/grade proof).</b></p>

<p><b>Matside Coaching/Coaching Passes:</b></p>	<p>Coaching passes may be obtained at the Safeguarding Desk. Coaches must produce a valid Governing Body Coach Award to receive a coaching pass.</p> <p>Only coaches with a coaching pass will be allowed matside. Only one coach should be matside per player at any one time</p>
