Eligibility:	All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA or JudoScotland. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation and confirmation of their grade. Cadets: Year of birth 2006, 2007, or 2008 – minimum grade - green belt (10th Mon) Pre-Cadets: Year of birth 2009 or 2010 – minimum grade - yellow belt (4th mon) Minors: Year of birth 2011 to 2014 – minimum grade - yellow belt (4th mon) It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
Competition Format:	Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout. Contest time: Cadet – 4 mins, Pre-Cadet & Minors - 3 mins The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook. This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes. IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No 30 second rule • BJA Technical Restrictions will apply to Minors categories. • Judogi measurements as per 2013 IJF rules. • 2017 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition. <p><u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event;</u> any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi must also have a white Judogi when required.</p> <p><u>Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.</u></p>
Weight Categories:	<p>Minor Male -27kg, -30kg, -34kg, -38kg, -u42kg, u46kg, u50kg, +50kg</p> <p>Minor Female -28kg, -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, +48kg</p> <p>Pre-Cadet Male -34kg, -38kg, -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, +73kg</p> <p>Pre-Cadet Female -32kg, -36kg, -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg, -70kg, +70kg (ARMLOCKS AND STRANGLES NOT PERMITTED)</p> <p>Cadet Male -42kg, -46kg, -50kg, -55kg, -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, +90kg</p> <p>Cadet Female -40kg, -44kg, -48kg, -52kg, -57kg, -63kg -70kg, +70kg (ARMLOCKS AND STRANGLES PERMITTED)</p> <p>Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the organisers must be notified of any weight category changes). Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).</p> <p>The Northern Ireland Judo Federation reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories.</p>

Registration and Weigh-In:	<p>The official weigh-in will take place on Saturday 22nd April 2023</p> <p>All Cadets - 08:15am – 08.45am</p> <p>All Minors - 11:00am – 11:30am</p> <p>All Pre-Cadets – 12noon – 12.30pm</p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their VALID judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing their grade.</p> <p>An Open weigh in will be conducted at this event therefore ALL competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt, (the following weight allowances will be given – u66/u63kg and below – 0.6kg allowance, u73/u70kg and above – 0.8kg allowance).</p> <p>Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for u73kg players must weigh over 66.5kg.</p> <p>Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.</p> <p>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area</p>
Competition Start:	<p>Saturday 22nd April 2023 Competition starts: 09.30am</p>
Matside Coaching/Coaching Passes:	<p>Coaching passes may be obtained at the Safeguarding Desk. Coaches must produce a valid BJA Coach Award card to receive a coaching pass.</p> <p>Only coaches with a coaching pass will be allowed matside. Only one coach should be matside per player at any one time</p>
