Eligibility:	All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA, Judo Scotland, BJC or AJA. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation
	Minors: Year of birth 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 only – minimum grade – yellow belt (4th Mon) – minimum age - 8 years on the day
	Pre-cadet: Year of birth 2010 and 2011 only – minimum grade – yellow belt (4th Mon)
	Cadet: Year of birth 2007, 2008 or 2009 – minimum grade - green belt (10th Mon)
	It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
Competition Format:	Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout.
	The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.
	This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.
	IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following;

	All genders of all ages in all BJA licenced events are entitled to wear a T-shirt / Rash Guard at both the weigh in and during the contest should they wish to do so.
	The standard T-shirt / Rash Guard worn in all categories will be plain white with a round neck collar and have a maximum sleeve length up to 5cm above the wrist joint.
	There will be no advertising on the T-shirt /rash guard of any description other than the standard manufacturers label, maximum size of manufacturers label will be 3cm x 15cm and not visible when the jacket is tied in its normal position.
	The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event; any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi <b>must</b> also have a white Judogi when required.

	The Northern Ireland Judo Federation reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories
	The official weigh-in will take place on Saturday 20th April 2024
Registrations and Weigh-In:	<b>All Cadets</b> - 08:15am – 08.45am
	<b>All Minors</b> - 11:00am – 11:30am
	All Pre-Cadets – 12noon – 12.30pm
	All competitors MUST bring their <b>VALID</b> judo licence/membership to registration and also their record book showing their grade (valid digital versions accepted).
	An Open weigh in will be conducted at this event therefore ALL competitors must weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers and a t-shirt, (a 0.8kg allowance will be given).
	Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for u73kg players must weigh over 66.8kg.
	All Cadets who compete at the Saturday event and are competing in the Junior event on the Sunday <u>must register and weigh-in for the Junior event</u> during the allocated times but they will not be required to make their weight category limit but should be within 5% of the maximum weight limit for their weight category.
	Players are NOT permitted to change in the designated official weigh-in area.
	The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area (except if required for membership/grade proof).
	Please note: Test scales will be available at registration (where the officials must be notified of any weight category changes).
	Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).

	Competition starts: 10.00am
Matside Coaching/Coaching Passes:	Coaching passes may be obtained at the Safeguarding Desk. Coaches must produce a valid Governing Body Coach Award to receive a coaching pass.

	Only coaches with a coaching pass will be allowed matside. Only one coach should be matside per player at any one time
