	Cadets: Year of birth 2007, 2008 and 2009
	Junior: Year of birth – 2004 to 2009
	Senior: Age 14+ on day of the competition
	Masters: Year of birth – Minimum age of 30 years on day of competition
	It is the judoka's/parent's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.
	Knockout with Compound Repechage for categories with eight or more competitors. Categories with fewer than eight competitors will be fought in pools or pools to knockout.
	Contest time: Cadets, Juniors, Senior - 4 mins
	Masters – 3 mins
Competition Format:	The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.
	This Tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.
	The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event.
	Medals – one Gold, one Silver and two Bronze (depending on number of entries) presented in each category.

	The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area.
