<b>Eligibility:</b>	<p>All players must have a current up-to-date membership of the BJA, NIJF, WJA or JudoScotland. All international players must produce proof of membership to their federation.</p> <p><b>Juniors:</b> Year of birth <b>2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 or 2008</b> – Contest time 4 mins.</p> <p><b>Seniors:</b> Year of birth – <b>Minimum age of 14 years</b> – Contest time 4 mins.</p> <p><b>Masters:</b> Year of birth – <b>Minimum age of 30 years</b> – Contest time 3 mins.</p> <p><b>A BJA Level 1 adaptive event will be run on the day for those wishing to compete alongside mainstream competitors.</b></p> <p>All competitors must bring their <b>JUDO LICENCE</b> to the weigh-in to confirm grade and eligibility.  <b>It is the competitor's responsibility to check that their Licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete.</b></p>
<b>Competition Format:</b>	<p>Knockout &amp; Compound Repechage System or Pools/Pools to Knockout (if fewer than 8)</p> <p>This tournament qualifies for points scoring for promotion purposes.</p> <p>The Tournament will be run under BJA Rules as per latest Tournament Handbook.</p> <p>IJF Rules will be in operation. Please note the following;</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No 30 second rule</li> <li>• Judogi measurements as per 2017 IJF rules.</li> <li>• 2017 IJF Red label judogi rules or the requirement to wear judogi of specific suppliers will not be rules at this competition.</li> </ul> <p><b><u>The wearing of WHITE judogi is compulsory at this event;</u></b> any competitors choosing to wear Blue Judogi must also have a white Judogi when required.</p> <p><b><u>Competitors should bring their own white and blue belts for competition use.</u></b></p>

	<p><b>KYU GRADES</b>          Players must be 16 years and over to compete Maximum grade – Brown belt (1st Kyu)          (Armlocks and strangles will be permitted in groups with Green (3rd Kyu) to Brown (1st Kyu) belts only).</p> <p><b>Masters category 1: 30-39 years of age</b></p> <p><b>Male</b>                                -60kg, -66kgs, -73kgs, -81kgs, -90kgs, -100kgs, +100kg</p> <p><b>Masters Category 2: 40-49 years of age</b></p> <p><b>Male</b>                                -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg</p> <p><b>Masters Category 3: 50+ years of age</b></p> <p><b>Male</b>                                -60kg, -66kg, -73kg, -81kg, -90kg, -100kg, +100kg</p> <p><b>It is the judoka's responsibility to check that their membership/licence is in date and that they meet the eligibility criteria to compete ie age and grade.</b></p> <p><b>Players can change weight categories during the registration process (weight changes must take place prior to the player stepping on the official weigh in scales).</b></p> <p><b>The tournament director reserves the right to amalgamate adjacent weight categories depending on the number of entries in the respective weight categories. This includes the amalgamation of age categories in the Masters categories depending on the number of entries.</b></p>
<p><b>Registration &amp; Weigh-In</b></p>	<p>The official registration and weigh-in will take place –</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> November 2022</b></p> <p><b>Juniors</b> -                                8.30am to 9am  <b>Seniors &amp; Masters</b> -                11am to 11.30am</p> <p><b><u>Please note:</u> Juniors who are competing in both Junior &amp; Senior categories should collect both their Junior and Senior registration cards and weigh in during the allocated Junior weigh in time.</b></p> <p>Players must weigh-in wearing underwear and will receive a 0.1kgs weight allowance. Players must satisfy the minimum weight limit for their category, ie for U73kg must weigh over 66.1kg.</p> <p><b><u>Please note:</u> No changes of weight category will be permitted after the player has weighed in on the official scales.</b></p> <p>All competitors MUST bring their <b>VALID</b> judo licence (BJA or affiliate) to registration and also their record book showing they meet the minimum grade requirement.</p> <p><b>The use of mobile phones is NOT PERMITTED in the weigh in area.</b></p>
